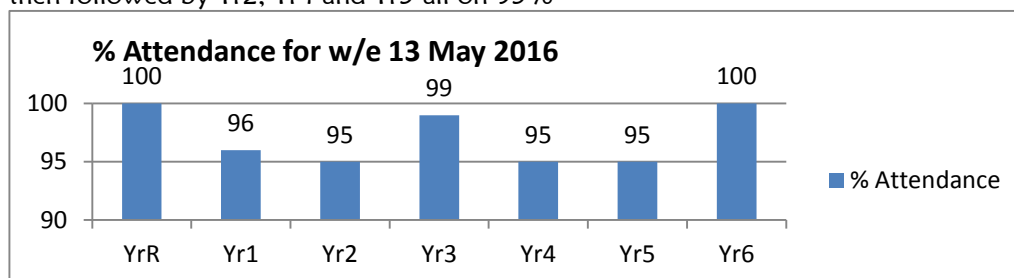




NEWSLETTER – Monday 23rd May 2016
