




NEWSLETTER – Monday 25th April 2016

As part of this, I chair the committee that looks at school policies as well as pupil achievement and progress.

Last week, Candice Dwight (Chair of Governors) and I spent a day in school. Our focus was the school priorities for this year.

We spent time in every year group and were impressed at how the Power of Reading and Kagan structures are used to engage pupils in their learning.

We saw a whole class debating a theme from their Power of Reading book, some letters written to a book character and got a sneak peek of this week's class assembly.

Speaking to both staff and pupils we got a real sense of how the Power of Reading is being utilised, particularly to improve writing across the school and were impressed by the level of pupil engagement, co-operation and challenge that the Kagan structures provided.
