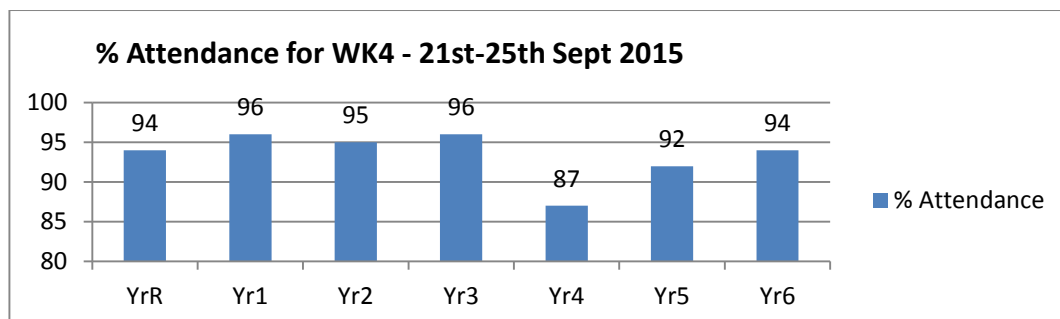




NEWSLETTER – Monday 28th September 2015

Attendance
