Dear Parents, Carers and Children

You will have no doubt heard the latest announcement from the Prime Minister that schools will not open for all children any time before the 8th March 2021. We are all hoping that this will be the date for all children to return to school.

For now, we will continue with our remote learning programme and key worker provision for the time ahead. I would like to thank all parents and carers for the wonderful job you are doing to support the children in their learning. I also want to stress that we all understand that this is tricky to manage as parents have their own jobs and busy home lives to manage. The last thing we want to do, is to put further pressure on parents. Please do let the teachers know if there is anything that they or the school can do to support you in this time and to make learning accessible for your children.

We will continue with our programme of live lessons and teachers will share their timetables on Google Classroom weekly and daily. We do expect that all children submit their work for Shared Reading, English and Maths after the live lessons. Teachers will feed back to the children and set their next steps for learning based on this work. If you are having trouble submitting this work, please speak to the teachers who will try and make this as easy as possible for children to do. For the main subjects that are timetabled, children should submit their work on that day. Teachers will also be adding recorded lessons to the timetable so that children can access some lessons at a time suitable to them.

I also want to thank all the children for what they are doing. Whenever I join a live lesson, I can see children actively engaging in their learning, asking questions, smiling and enjoying the time to see one another. You have all done very well and I want to encourage you to keep going, to keep trying so hard and to keep up your super attitude to this very different way of learning. I asked some of you yesterday to tell me about your experiences of remote learning and lockdown and it was very interesting to hear your viewpoints. You were able to tell me that you enjoy some aspects of remote learning and that there are things that are quite fun. You also told me what you don't like and how much you are missing your friends and school. All the teachers and I miss having you at school too.

I am looking forward to seeing all of you online next week and reading some of the fantastic work you are submitting every day.
