



### Pupil Premium Statement:

#### What is Pupil Premium?

Pupil Premium (PP) is money that the government allocates to schools on the basis of:

Free School Meals allocation

Looked After Children

Special Guardianship Children

Child Arrangement Orders

Children Adopted from Care

It also includes Nursery aged children when parents are in receipt of certain government benefits:

Income Support

Income based Jobseeker's Allowance

Income related Employment and Support Allowance

Support under Part VI of the Asylum Act 199

The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit

Child Tax Credit (provided parents are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more that £16,190)

Working Tax Credit run on, which is paid for 4 weeks after parents stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Universal Credit

#### **Pupil Premium at Woodford Green Primary:**

As a school we are committed to raising achievement for pupils who are eligible for Pupil Premium and understand that many of these pupils must make accelerated progress compared to non-eligible pupils to achieve this. We use the pupil premium grant to support pupils and raise education attainment and tackle a range of barriers in order to achieve this.

#### **Monitoring pupil progress and attainment:**

We consistently and rigorously monitor and evaluate the impact of Pupil Premium funding. We track the progress of children over time as this is essential in identifying need and developing strategies and interventions to accelerate progress. The data we collect is consistently used in internal pupil progress meetings and Trust Board Standards meetings which take place termly.
