This term our topic is Why did so many Vikings leave home?

Our topic will cover: **History**

We will continue to explore the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. This will include: Viking life, raids and invasion, resistance by Alfred the Great and Athelstan, the first king of England, further Viking invasions and Danegeld, Anglo-Saxon laws and justice and Edward the Confessor and his death in 1066.

Our Power of Reading Book is **There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom** by Louis Sachar

In **Maths** we will be covering:

- Roman Numerals
- Factor pairs to solve mental calculations
- Adding and subtracting fractions with common denominators
- Decimal values of any number of tenths or hundredths
- Decimal equivalents of fractions
- Symmetry and reflection
- Coordinates
- Reading graphs and data

In **RE** we will be continuing to learn about **Sikhism**. There will be a workshop to introduce the children to Sikh traditions and way of life.

Our **PE** sessions will cover athletics and ball skills.

Outdoor PE will take place on **Monday** and **Wednesday**. Children will need to be appropriately dressed for both sessions.

On **Tuesdays** the children will have **Computing and French**.

On **Wednesdays** the children will have **RE and PE** with Coach Lucas.
