**Please remember to return any reply slips (for trips, after school clubs etc.) and money to the class teacher and not to the school office. Many thanks for your co-operation.**

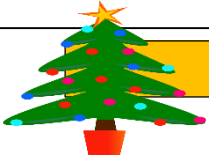
