Easter Holiday Football

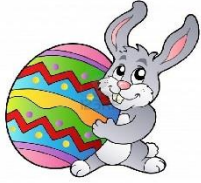

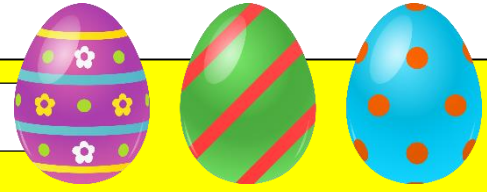
PAYMENT TRIPS, MILK, UNIFORM ETC
