Give three reasons for your choice. <p>Can you add any more questions to this quiz that you can ask your family?</p>	<p>Flags Geography Flag Making</p> <p>Find out which North American countries have red in their flag and draw your favourite one.</p> 	<p>Making a Meal Food Technology</p> <p>Research, plan and help prepare a meal or snack from a country within North America. Maybe you could create a variation on this meal or snack by adding other ingredients. I love Mexican Salsa and often add different ingredients in rather than following the recipe exactly...yum yum!</p>	<p>Memory Game Geography</p> <p>Write out the names of the countries in North America on separate pieces of paper. Try to memorise as many as you can. Towards the end of the week ask someone in your family to test your memory. Perhaps you can draw something from each country to add to each name to help you remember.</p>

Look at this map!</p>  <p>Can you find out what the highest and lowest temperatures ever recorded were?</p>	<p>Heroes History & PSHE</p> <p>Just like last week, there are many people of North American heritage that have had a positive impact on making the world we live in today a better place. We would like you to research an individual of your choice. You could create a fact file or maybe even write them a letter? What is the reason for this? Which are your favourites? Where do they live? Have they got any features to help them adapt to the environment they live in? You could record this however you like; create a fact file, a power point, a poster, a news article (written or recorded) or anything else creative.</p>

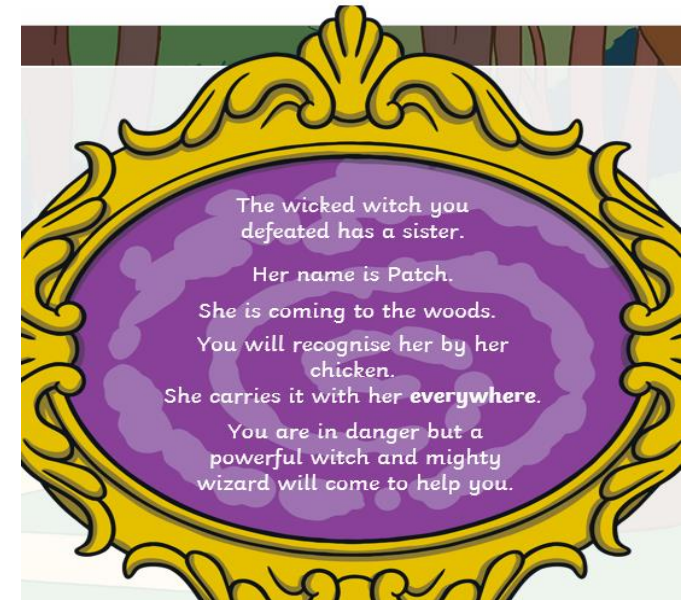
