| <h2 style="text-align: center;">Manga</h2> <p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>Manga is an art form, a type of Japanese comic book or graphic novel. First published in Japan in the early nineteenth century, it has become more popular and widespread in recent years. Manga is the form of telling a story through illustration. These stories often involve adventure or humour. Manga has a specific style. It is drawn by hand in pencil, or pen and ink. Characters are depicted with large eyes, small mouths and often unnatural hair colour. Much manga is still printed in black and white.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Draw a circle, with a light line down the middle. 2. Draw two vertical lines from both sides of the circle, angling towards the central line, to create a chin. 3. Half way down the circle, draw the eyebrows and below that, large eyes. 4. Halfway down the bottom half of the face, draw a simple line for the nose, or two nostrils. Add ears, with the bottom in line with the nose. 5. Add a simple lip outline, halfway between the nose and chin. 6. Add choppy hair, with sweeping strands. 7. Add colour and further details to depict your character's emotions.  | <h2 style="text-align: center;">Nature</h2> <p style="text-align: center;">Geography/Science</p> <p>Vietnam's mountainous terrain, forests, wetlands, and long coastline contain many different habitats that support a great variety of wildlife. Some 270 types of mammals, 180 reptiles, 80 amphibians, and 800 bird species reside in Vietnam.</p> <p>Research some of the wildlife in Vietnam and create a poster, a fact file or record yourself presenting some interesting facts!</p>  | <h2 style="text-align: center;">Languages</h2> <p style="text-align: center;">MFL</p> <p>There are more than 4.3 billion people speaking nearly 2,300 living languages across Asia. You've probably heard of some of the common ones, like Mandarin, Chinese and Japanese! It is located on the south bank of the Yamuna River in Agra, India.</p> <p>Make a model of the Taj Mahal. The festival lasts for three days, and usually starts on April 13th. This is the beginning of the astrological year. Songkran is also known as the 'water festival' as many people celebrate by throwing and splashing water all over each other!</p> <p>The water is believed to wash away any sadness from the previous year.</p> <p>What sadness would you wash away from the last school year? His principles and firm belief in non-violence have been followed by many other important civil rights leaders including Martin Luther King, Jr. and Nelson Mandela. Gandhi was nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize on several occasions but never won, even though many felt he should have.
