Activity:

With the help of an adult can you cut up a banana into 6 slices. Can you share out the banana into 2 bowls equally. What would happen if you had another bowl? What would happen if you put too many slices into 1 bowl? How can you make sure you have the same number of slices in each bowl. Encourage your child to share the slices one at a time that way all the slices will be shared out equally.
