Dear Parent and Carer,

You may be aware that all primary schools begin testing staff for the coronavirus twice a week from 25<sup>th</sup> January. We are pleased this has come into place so we can ensure that we are not putting your children at risk by spending all day in a room with an adult who has the virus but no symptoms.

Whilst we very much hope that none of our staff test positive, we are aware that there is a possibility of some of our staff being identified to have the virus. If this is the case, we will need to send them, and the children in their bubble, home to isolate for 10 days as per government requirements.

If this happens, we will ensure your child receives the same remote offer as others already learning from home. For those without suitable technology, we will do all we can to provide you with the resources you need.

I am hoping that, by contacting you in advance, you will have time to consider how you might manage in the event that your child has to self-isolate. I have added a link to the government guidance on childcare support bubbles for children up to the age of 14.
