House Captains will come round to visit the classrooms each day after lunch to sell the poppies. All other items will be available for children to purchase from the school office. Wishing Tree Project (proposed dates: 25th November – 7th December)



From Friday 25th November, there will be a special Christmas tree in the school reception area displaying gift tags, each with details of a child linked to Faithworks – the charity we will be supporting this year. The aim is for as many people from the school community to take a gift tag, buy and wrap the present and then bring this back into school, via the school office with the tag attached. Gift tags can be taken any time and the last day for presents to be collected is **Wednesday 7th December.** The gifts will then be passed onto the children in time for Christmas! The tags have specific information about the age and gender of the child (e.g. girl, aged 5). The present does not have to be expensive, about £5 is suggested however it needs to be brand new rather than second hand goods.
