School Uniform

Dear Parents/Carers,

This letter is a reminder about our uniform expectations at Bishop Aldhelm's. This is the same as the letter sent out in March although this time we have added pictures to help.

Children are able to wear either the formal uniform or the PE uniform. PE uniform must be worn on your child's PE days. On the other days, it is your choice which they wear. Please ensure that whichever type they choose to wear, it is fully in line with the expectations for that uniform.

Choices for uniform:

Formal uniform: grey v-neck sweater or cardigan

White polo shirt- EYFS/KS1 White shirt and tie- KS2

Grey trousers/grey shorts/grey pleated skirt/grey pinafore dress

Red gingham summer dress

Black shoes

Please note the following shouldn't be worn with formal uniform: white shirts in KS2 without a tie, white polo shirts in KS2, red jumpers/cardigans or trainers.

PE Uniform: red sweatshirt/ red hoodie/ red ¼ zip BAPS zip top Red polo shirt- can be with or without the school logo- no other logos Plain red shorts- no logos or stripes Plain red sports socks or white conventional socks Plain black tracksuit bottoms or black leggings- no logos. Plain black or white trainers



Please note the following shouldn't be worn with PE uniform: trainers of different colours (they must be plain black or white), leggings or jogging bottoms that aren't black, bottoms that have logos on them.
