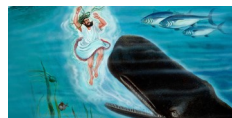
We are learning about the Gospels, God and what Jesus taught.

Knowledge I will learn

I know that Christians believe that Jesus brings the good news (Gospel) and that God loves them and he will forgive them when they go wrong.
 I know the story of the calling of Matthew (including why the tax collector was unpopular, and how people reacted) the tax collector and that Jesus chose as his closest friends (disciples) many who were friendless.
 I know that Christians believe in God and that they find out about him in the Bible.
 I know that Christians worship God and pray to him. I can identify different types of prayer i.e. Praise: saying sorry: asking: and saying thank you.
 I know that Christians believe that by forgiving they will find peace in their own lives, with others, and with God.
 I know that Christians believe that God is loving kind forgiving and fair
 I know that Christians will pray to God prayers to say sorry to ask for things to say thank you.
 I know that a parable is 'a story to help people understand ideas'.
 I know and can name different beliefs and practices, including festivals, worship, rituals and ways of life, and find out about the meanings behind them.

kindness,	Listening, feeling and understanding someone else's needs and then reacting to them.
good news	God loves everyone
gospel	The four gospels are books in the Bible which tell us about Jesus' life
forgive/ forgiveness	Letting go of angry feelings towards other when they have done something to upset us
tax collector	Someone who collect money for the Government
disciples	People who followed Jesus (he had 12)
prayer	Talking to God
worship	Praising God by singing, reading the Bible and praying
praise	Being thankful to God and joyful about what he has done
peace	Everyone is happy and there is no arguing
fair	Everyone being treated equally
Salvation	Being saved from evil or bad things
