CLUBS INFORMATION AUTUMN TERM 2026

For the Autumn Term **the cost to attend a club will be £20 for the whole term (10 weeks)**. All school run clubs will be running for 10 sessions (£2 per session) - £20 total cost for Autumn Term. (This will vary for Rock Steady & Little Performers as these are outside run clubs).

All club bookings are through the ARBOR APP and payment will be required to secure your child's place. The payment is non-refundable so please go through details of the club with your child before they are available to book.

All we ask is that your child is committed to joining in and that this is something they are genuinely interested in being part of for the whole term. To help you discuss the options with your children there is a short synopsis to explain the context of some clubs. **We are unable to amend any bookings once you have booked in.**

To book the club, the payment must be made in full. Refunds are not possible should your child be absent on the day of the club, or if your child no longer wishes to attend or is attending a sporting event.

We ask families to be considerate of all families when accessing these clubs and view them as an extra curricular activity rather than additional childcare. Therefore please book your child on their first preference and wait to see if there are other options available before booking for multiple clubs for your child/ren to give everyone fair access.

Should a club you wish to access becomes full then please request to be placed on a waiting list or please see if there is another club still available to book.

We have thought carefully about our offer across the whole school year and making sure we offer places as fairly as possible for each year group.

When booked should your child no longer wish to attend we will not be offering a refund, which is why we have given details to enable you to discuss what your child will enjoy prior to booking the club. If your child is ill then no refund will be given for the session. Should there be a time the club is cancelled, if possible, we will extend the end date for the club to make sure they are all offered the full amount of sessions throughout the term. If this is not possible then a refund will be issued through Arbor.

CLUB DESCRIPTIONS

Football Club- The football club is for all year groups and is open to girls and boys. It is running on a Wednesday after school and being run by members of our PE Team. All members of the club will need suitable outdoor clothing, shin pads and trainers, football boots OR astro trainers, to take part.



Tag Rugby – This club is for all year groups and is open to girls and boys. It is running on a Tuesday after school and being run by members of our PE Team. All members of the club will need suitable outdoor clothing and trainers to take part.

Dodgeball Club – This club is for all year groups and is open to girls and boys. It is running on a Monday after school and being run by members of our PE Team. All members of the club will need suitable clothing and trainers to take part.

Clay Club - Come and get creative and enjoy having fun! Learn to use various skills and techniques to make some wonderful pots and ornaments. During the 10 sessions we will learn skills and techniques such as pinching, coiling, decorative techniques and tile making. This club is running on a Thursday after school.

Little Performers – This is a street dance club which is taking place on a Wednesday after school. Further information attached. All bookings are direct with Little Performers and not the school.

Rock Steady – Fun and inclusive rock and pop band lessons for all year groups. Further information attached. All bookings are direct with Rock Steady and not the school.

Come Along with Cooper Club - Learn about caring for a pet correctly, how to act around animals and come and help give Cooper some exercise every session. Please note as the weather can be unpredictable your child should make sure they have a waterproof coat, warm items and waterproof shoes (not wellies, just not fabric covered ones) as we will likely be walking on a muddy field at points! This is open to years 4, 5 or 6 and is running on a Thursday after school.

RELEASE DATES AND BOOKING DETAILS

Please refer to the separate club timetable which states when each club is available to book through Arbor.

All clubs are limited, so places will be issued on a first-come-first-served basis as they are booked. Please bear in mind that spaces are filled extremely quickly, so please set your reminders for the date and time they will be going live.

For Rock Steady & Little Performers please refer to their separate information sheet.

Please book a space for the club your child would like to attend through the Arbor App.

Full payment is required when you book to secure the place for your child. The office is unable to book spaces for anyone as payment is required from a parent at the time of booking.

We are sending this letter out with plenty of notice so you have a chance to read through and address any queries you may have before the clubs go live and are available to book. We do hope that the selection of clubs available will appeal to all of our children and with more spaces open to them, a greater number of pupils will be able to join.
