
How the scheme works:

Money is added onto the Healthy Start card every 4 weeks and recipient receives:

- £4.25 each week of pregnancy from the 10th week
- £8.50 each week for children from birth to 1 year old
- £4.25 each week for children between 1 and 4 years old
- Families can also obtain free vitamins from their local family centre in Hertfordshire find out more at:




We have been making pneumatic monsters as part of our DT unit.

"I was surprised to learn that vaping is addictive and that if you drink the liquid you will be very ill. I would not recommend it because it becomes very expensive." Lewis




### A peek into ...
