Sports Day Information – Tuesday 23rd June 2026

We are pleased to let you know that we are planning to hold our Sports Day on Tuesday 23rd June 2026, with children competing within their house teams.

- Year 3 & 4: 9:30am – 11:30am
- Year 5 & 6: 1:30pm – 3:00pm

All children are aware of their house teams, however if you are unsure, please check with your child's Class Teacher, Teaching Assistant or a member of the PE Team before Sports Day.

Practice Sports Day – Tuesday 9th June 2026

Please can all children come into school wearing their PE kit and an item in their house colour (for example: a t-shirt, hairband, wristband or socks).

If the weather is sunny, please be aware that there is very little shade on the school field. All children will therefore need:

- A named water bottle
- Sun cream applied before school
- A sun hat
- Trainers suitable for running and outdoor activities

Sports Day – Tuesday 23rd June 2026

Please can all children again come into school wearing:

- Their PE kit
- An item in their house colour
- Trainers

If **sunny** weather is forecast, children will also require:

- A named water bottle
- Sun cream applied before school
- A sun hat

If you are able to arrange for your child to bring an umbrella, this can also be a very effective way of helping provide additional shade alongside the gazebos that will be in place.

Parents and carers are very welcome to attend and watch the events. Refreshments will be available to purchase for adults, so if you would like to buy drinks or snacks, please bring some loose change. You may also wish to bring a picnic rug or camping chair so that you are comfortable during the event.

- Year 5 & 6: 1:30pm – 3:00pm



If you are attending both the morning and afternoon sessions, please be aware that parents/carers will not be able to remain on site between events and will need to leave the premises at the end of the morning session before returning for the afternoon session.

Access to the Field

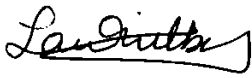
Parents/carers attending should enter via the green gates near the main office. Please note that the wooden gates near the Infant School access will not be open during these times.
