Spain	A country in Western Europe
Country	an area of land that is controlled by its own government
City	A large town
Continent	one of the earth's seven major areas of land
population	The number of people living in a particular country, area, or place
Human Features	Natural characteristics of a place, such as mountains, rivers, or forests
Physical Features	the study of the Earth's natural features, such as mountains, rivers, deserts and oceans
Region	An area with common physical or human features
Climate	The usual weather conditions in a region
