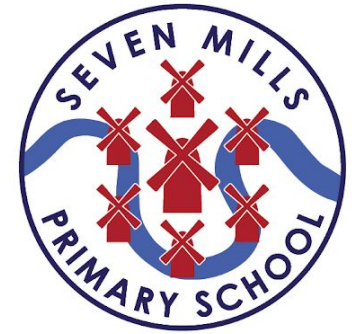
Behaviour



At Seven Mills, we use positive behaviour management strategies to ensure our children feel happy and confident in lessons. We use a range of preventative measures to stop poor behaviour occurring, and give children the chance to 'fix up' before putting sanctions in place. The strategies are designed to ensure that 'first attention goes to best conduct' and to create a culture and climate of a learning community motivated to always try their best.



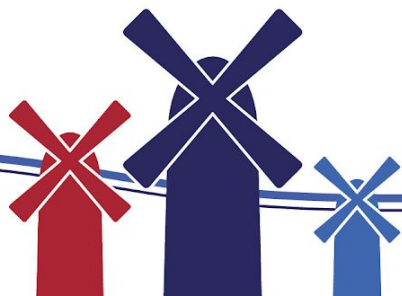
Home Reading

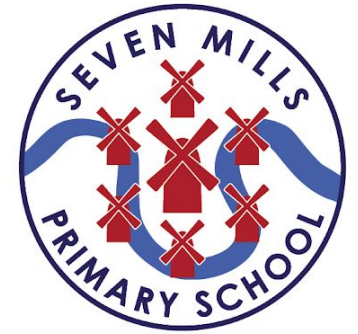
KS2 - 25 minutes each day

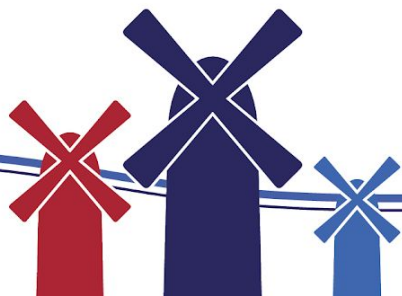
Home-Learning



Children in Year 1 - 6 will receive an optional pack of home learning each half term. This will contain:

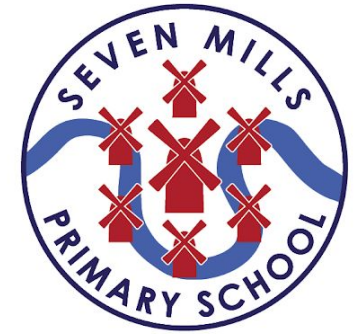
- Weekly spellings

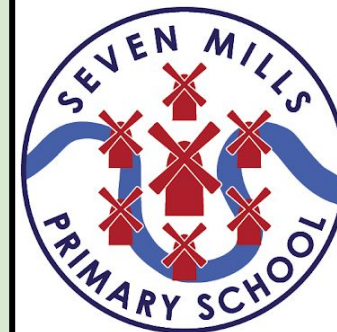
Breakfast Club

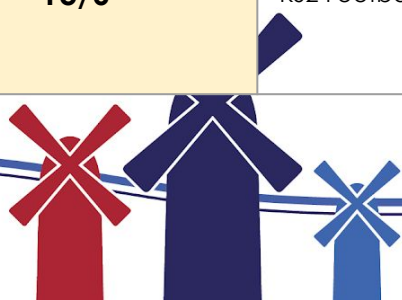
After School Clubs are an opportunity for children to develop their talents and interests. Clubs will start on Monday 11th September, from 3:30-4:30.

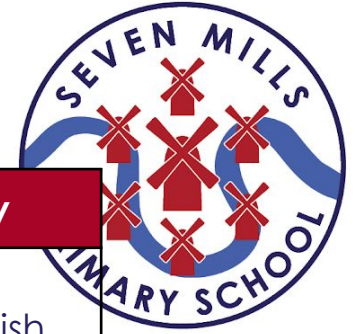

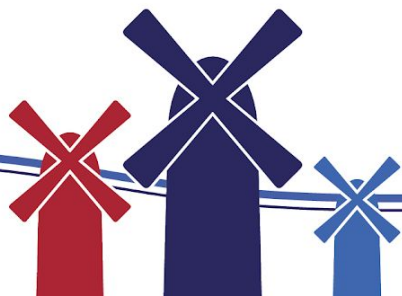
Parent Workshops/ Volunteering



A variety of parent workshops will take place on Thursday mornings throughout the year with Shabana and Momothaj, our parent support workers.

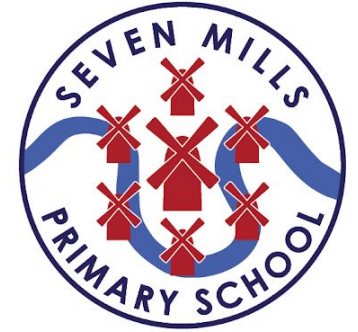
These will be based around a variety of topics from keeping your children safe online to mental health and wellbeing.
