Big congratulations to these guys who took part in a curling competition at Mile End leisure centre.

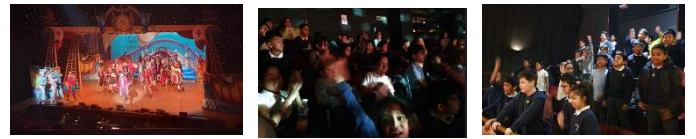
Cross Country Running
