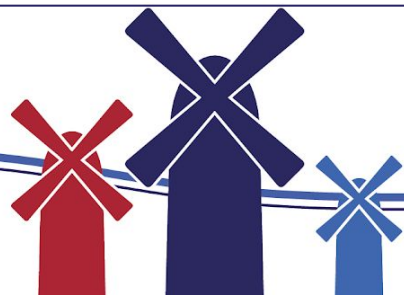

A ? ! , ' "" • Use () ,, or -- for parenthesis • Use commas to clarify meaning • Spell all of Y1-Y4 rules • Use a dictionary • Clear joined handwriting 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be secure on Y3/Y4 Spelling Rules • Have an understand of the Y5/Y6 Spelling rules 	<p><u>Number and Place Value</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10 000 000 and determine the value of each digit • Round any whole number to a required degree of accuracy • Use negative numbers and calculate intervals across zero <p><u>Operations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Multiply multi-digit numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number • Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using long division • Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit number • Perform mental calculations, including with mixed operations and large numbers • Identify common factors, common multiples and prime numbers • Use their knowledge of the order of operations to carry out calculations involving the four operations
