Woodland Walk

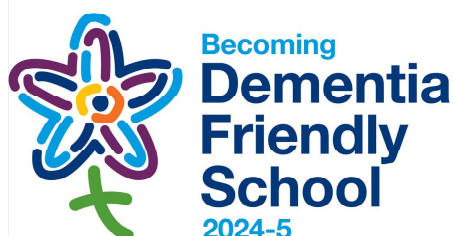
