

Year 6 Curriculum Letter Spring 2nd Half Term 2020

Dear Parents,

I hope you have had a relaxing half term. As the Year 6 SATs approach please make sure the children let us know which areas they need more support with, so we can revisit these in school.

We are continuing to concentrate on our Maths and English learning. This half term in Maths, we are continuing to practise all 4 calculations, especially the written methods. Furthermore, we are learning about fractions, percentages, decimals and measure as well as about ratio and proportion. Problem solving strategies and mathematical thinking are also a key focus.

In English we will be learning about persuasive writing, making posters, writing a newspaper article and a persuasive story. After that, we will continue with non-chronological reports. We will also carry on learning more about grammar and spelling rules.

In Science this half term, we will continue learning about Classification and then start our topic on Evolution and Inheritance.

In RE, the children will be investigating the topic of salvation and explore the following question about Christianity: What did Jesus do to save human beings?

Our topic work, taught by Mrs Archbold, will focus on Geography. The children will learn about South America.
