Classes 2, 3 & 4

Being Responsible:

- Water spillage helping people, preventing accidents, responsible & irresponsible.
- Practice makes perfect ways to improve, not giving up, practising & setting goals.
- Helping someone in need help others, kind & thoughtful behaviours, risks of talking to people you don't know, being responsible & irresponsible.

Classes 8, 9 &10 Being Responsible:

- Looking out for others actions when someone is unkind, caring & considerate behaviour, behave appropriately & how negative choices can impact others.
- Steeling what is consent, honesty, trusting relationships & how negative choices can impact others.
