Classes 2, 3 & 4

Keeping and Staying Healthy:

- Washing hands why we wash our hands, germs, affects on our health & healthy and unhealthy choices.
- Eating healthy food needed to keep us health and help us grow,
 & healthy and unhealthy choices.
- Brushing teeth why we brush our teeth, practise brushing teeth
 & healthy and unhealthy choices.

• Is it safe to eat and drink? – food and drink that is safe & unsafe.

Classes 8, 9 & 10

- Smoking & adult's and children's views - risks associated with smoking, name addictive ingredients, effect on health & wellbeing & strategies to resist pressure.
- Alcohol risks & choices, effect on health & strategies to resist pressure.
