COMPETITIONS & MORE

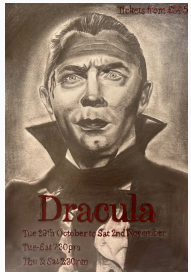
Competitions are an excellent way of highlighting and celebrating the student talent that exists within our schools. These have included:
