TVLP Students Solve Crime

Windsor Girls' School hosted two TVLP crime scene investigation workshops on 2nd November 2022, led by The Forensic Experience.

57 students from across 6 TVLP schools (Beechwood School, Holyport College, Eton College, Slough & Eton C of E Business & Enterprise College, The Langley Academy, and Windsor Girls' School) learnt about forensics, got to assess a crime scene and collect evidence, and had to decide who committed the crime.

100% of students reported they enjoyed the event and they learnt something new, with comments including, "[I enjoyed] how interactive the workshop was and the anecdotes" (Holyport College student) and "I enjoyed using various equipment to discover fingerprints and many other clues to find the killer. Overall, it was great!" (The Langley Academy student.)

It was a great opportunity for our students interested in science, and/or a potential career in forensics and crime investigation.

TVLP Languages Event

The Langley Academy was proud to host the TVLP French and Spanish languages event for 142 pupils in Years 9 and 10 from across 8 schools in the Thames Valley Learning Partnership.

To start, students were greeted by a feast of different French and Spanish foods. These included different cheeses, meats, potato gratin, soup, French baguettes and Spanish olive cake.

This was followed by a travel presentation, a tourism postcard competition (1st and 2nd place going to Olive Williamson and Poppy Knowles, students at the Windsor Girls' School), a guest speaker (Dr Marion Joassin, Royal Holloway, University of London), and the final of the 2023 TVLP French Spelling Bee competition.

Feedback was overwhelmingly positive, with 91% of pupils stating they enjoyed the event, 79% learning new information and 71% of students trying a food they'd never eaten before.
