

Terms and Conditions

- Students are expected to attend all lessons. If a student misses a session due to an unavoidable reason (e.g. illness), students must catch up with the work from that session. Most sessions will be uploaded onto Google Classroom. Students should seek advice from their supervisor if they have any doubt about what they should do.
- Students are expected to utilise the session time appropriately and act in accordance with the school's behaviour policy.
- The timetabled time consists of 30 hours. Students will also need to work on their projects outside of sessions and students must be prepared to do so. This should consist of 90 hours. Students need to highlight two non-contact periods on their timetable and complete the Google form stating their selected periods. Students should also be spending time on their project for homework.
- Students are expected to meet the given deadlines. These are outlined below for your information.
- There are three aspects to the course. Students are required to complete a presentation to an audience. Students must be prepared to do this.
- Another aspect of the course is a production log. This must be completed in detail, periodically (and in accordance with the deadlines) and not retrospectively.
- The 5000 word report requires thorough research and students are therefore expected to do wider reading.
- According to the exam board rubric, once the project is marked, it is deemed complete and the project cannot be revised and remarked.
- According to the exam board rubric, the school can only provide a score and not a grade. Students cannot ask for a grade – estimated or otherwise. A grade will be established and reported by the exam body.
