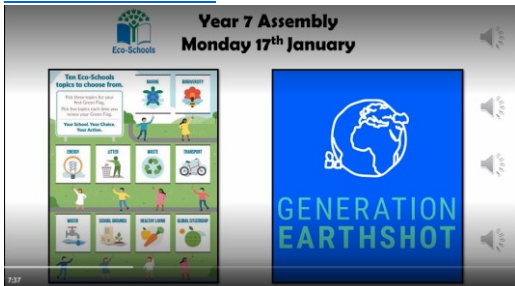

Open your wardrobe and be honest. How long was it since you last wore some of those clothes? Do you think it might be time for a clear out?

There's no need for any clothing or textiles to make its way into a bin. By donating your clothes instead, you can help fight landfill, reduce demand for clothes, and have a real impact in making fashion more sustainable.

DONATE OR REUSE AS SOMETHING ELSE!

350,000 tonnes, that's around £140 million worth of used but still wearable clothing goes to landfill in the UK every year

This would reduce the carbon, water and waste footprints of clothing consumption by 10-20% each.

We Great Britons send 700,000 tonnes of clothing to recycling centres, textile, clothes collections and banks to charity each year. That's enough to fill 459 Olympic-size swimming pools.

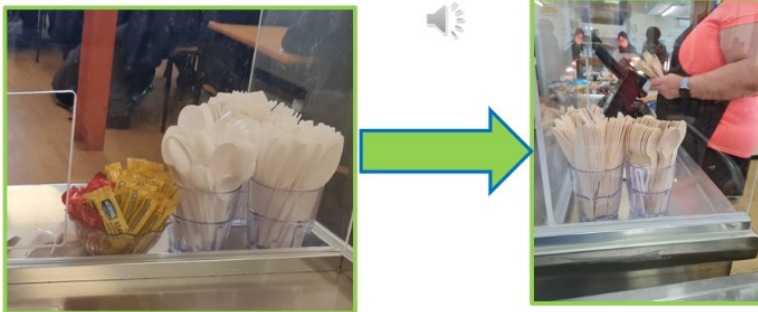




Marine

Vegetable oil recycling (end of Blue stairs)

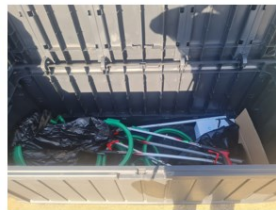
