

What happens when I report bullying?

Report the bullying incident to a member of staff, peer mentor, friend or use the Whisper Tool.



The member of staff who has received the report will pass this onto the relevant Head of Learning.



The Head of Learning will discreetly meet with the alleged victim and actively listen about the bullying incident.



The alleged victim will be consulted before a course of action is decided.



Written statements will be taken from alleged victim and alleged perpetrator and where possible, witnesses to the incident.



When appropriate parents should be informed and may be asked to come in to a meeting to discuss the problem.



We will provide appropriate support to help the alleged perpetrator (perpetrators) change their behaviour and the alleged perpetrator will be monitored.



The school maintains a central register of bullying incidents and follow up. If necessary and appropriate, police will be consulted.
