BeyondAutism


The school is working with BeyondAutism, a charity which provides outreach and consultancy services to schools with the aim of delivering life changing outcomes for children and young adults with autism.

Weather tracker: flash floods as Europe's heatwave ends with thunderstorms

Record-breaking heatwaves in Europe have ended in torrential showers and storms. Intense rainfall across England has led to flight disruptions at major international airports such as Gatwick. Winds of up to 75mph in Italy have led to disruptions on the Genoa-La Spezia line and parts of the peninsula have seen hail up to 6cm in diameter. In France, a violent thunderstorm led to 3 fatalities and left 45,000 houses without power. The torrential rains mixed with the dry soil has led to flash flooding, where many cities have seen disruptions in public transport due to waterlogged streets. Devastating flash floods in western China have led to 18 deaths and 36 missing.





Work Experience at Rapp Design Agency GCSE Graphics Students' KFC Game Concept

In early September, six of our talented GCSE Graphics students attended two weeks work experience at Rapp Design agency in London Bridge. They were tasked with working as one team to research, design and create a concept for a KFC rewards game which they were required to pitch to the Design Team. Whilst at Rapp they had the opportunity to meet creative directors, copy writers and illustrators and take part in design workshops. Design Lead Lionel Cull who ran the project said, "They produced work that I'd expect from postgraduates – the key was their thirst for learning and teamwork. They were able to take on feedback which is a regular occurrence in this industry, but this meant they could deliver a great idea. Their illustration skills blew my team away, they should be very proud of themselves."

MATHS NEWS



It is wonderful to see so many students engaging with the homework and revision resources on Hegarty Maths so early in the year.

If your child has not yet logged on to Hegarty Maths or has forgotten their password, then please ask them to follow the instructions below:

How do I log in?

How does a student log in

To log in, follow this process:

1. Start

From the website, www.hegartymaths.com, click on "Student log in"

2. School

Find your school - start typing - your school should show in the list. You can also use the postcode of the school if that's easier.

3. Details

Enter First name, Last name, and Date of birth. These must be the same as the details on the school register. Names are cAsE insEnSiTivE, so it doesn't matter if you write them in *lower* case or *UPPER* case or a *MiX*.

4. Password

The first time you log in, the system asks you to choose a password which you will need to write twice. Create a memorable password so you do not forget it. Only a teacher can reset a student password, so choose carefully! (Maybe write it down inside the cover of your maths book?)

The next time you log in, you'll just be asked for your password once.

If you have forgotten your password, click the link to request your teacher to reset it. They won't get the message until the next time *they* log in to HegartyMaths, so **don't leave your homework until the last minute!**



by Lesley Nneka Arimah.


This prize-winning collection of short stories deals in realist fiction, fantasy and cautionary fables, exploring themes such as

With a rare and compelling voice, this haunting novel tells not only the story of a remarkable girl and her incredible strength, but also of a time and place in which slavery was the order of the day and lives were valued like weights of meat or bundles of vegetables. Hannah liked this book because it gives a compelling yet shocking insight into the life of someone who had to endure slavery.

KEEPING YOU AND YOUR PHONE SAFE

Getting a phone is really exciting. You can stay in touch with friends and find out more about the world.

Don't fight back, it's not worth the risk when a phone can be replaced.

- **Tell us if someone robs you or tries to. It's important you get help straight away by dialling 999 using a friend or trusted adult's phone rather than contacting police when you get home. This gives us the best chance to catch the suspects, recover stolen items and make sure you're safe.**

- **If you don't want to talk to police – contact Fearless online, without giving your name, at www.fearless.org**
- **Memorise or keep a note of a parent/carer's phone number in a separate place in case of emergency.**

As police officers, our job is to keep you safe and stop people who want to steal property like phones, cash, earphones and even expensive coats or trainers.

You can help us do that by being careful where you use your phone and taking care of cash and other valuable items.

YOU CAN HELP US PROTECT AND TRACK YOUR PHONE IF IT'S STOLEN.

HERE'S 3 THINGS YOU CAN DO:

- **Your phone will have security features such as a passcode or fingerprint/face ID. Make sure you use it to protect access to your phone.**

5 TIPS TO KEEP SAFE

- **Keep your phone and valuables out of sight and in a safe place. Take care when you take them out especially near bus stops and train stations.**
- **Stay alert and remember earphones/headphones can distract you from being aware of someone approaching from behind you. Thieves can approach on mopeds, e-scooters and pedal cycles.**
- **Tracker apps can help locate your phone if it's lost or stolen. Ask a parent to show you how to set one up.**
- **Record the phone's IMEI number in a separate place at home. Find this by typing in ***#06#**. You'll need to give this number to police if it's stolen.**
