

Homework Platform Guidance

Microsoft Office 365



Kingsdale uses the Microsoft Office 365 platform for its Students, which includes Email, Teams, OneDrive, Word, Excel and more.

To log on to MS O365:

1. Go to www.office.com and click 'Sign in'.
2. Enter your school email address and password. If asked, choose 'Work or School'.
3. Once signed in, click on 'Apps' and then Outlook or Teams as needed.

Satchel One



Download the App or Access Online:

www.satchelone.com

To Download the app:

Search for "Satchel One" in your device's app store and download it.

Students Login:

1. Login either in the App or online at www.satchelone.com
2. Leave all the fields empty and then click 'Sign in with Office 365'
3. Login using your school email and password (same as for Teams/Office 365)

Parents Access:

Visit the Satchel One website and create a parent account using the code provided by your child's school.

Log In and Link Your Child's Account:

- **Enter credentials:** Use your login information to access your parent account.
- **Link your child:** Follow the prompts to link your child's account to your parent account. You may need a unique code provided by your child's school.

Explore the Features:

Once logged in, you'll have access to various features that provide valuable information about your child's school life:

- **Calendar:** View your child's upcoming events, holidays, and exam dates.
- **Homework:** See assigned homework tasks, due dates, and any submitted work.
- **Messages:** Communicate with teachers and the school directly through the messaging system.
- **Timetable:** Access your child's weekly timetable to stay informed about their schedule.
- **Reports:** View your child's academic progress and receive updates on their performance.

How to get started:

1. Students access the platform by clicking a link in their welcome email (check school email account) where they create a password and can begin using the platform.
2. Login on www.unifrog.org using your school email address as username and enter this password.
3. You can access from any computer, tablet or smartphone.

Tip: We encourage you to use the Unifrog platform with your child, so you can support them through the process of deciding their next steps.

Forgot your password? Visit www.unifrog.org, enter username (school email address) and click on 'Reset password'. You will then be able to reset the password (via your student email account).

How to login:
