

Latin Curriculum Year 10-11 Additional Information

The examination board used by Kingsdale for GCSE Latin, Eduqas, assesses students through three components, each of which is examined through a separate paper as follows:

Component	GCSE Weighting
Paper 1: Language	50%
Paper 2: Literature	30%
Paper 3: Civilisation	20%

Eduqas updates the content of the Literature and Civilisation components every three years, providing options for schools to choose from. As detailed in the Latin Curriculum Year 7-11, these components are studied during Years 10 and 11.

For GCSE examinations sat from 2027 to 2029, Kingsdale teaches the following options:

Literature (Component 2): *Come Dine with Me*

Civilisation (Component 3B, Topic 8): *Roman Festivals and Worship*
