

Sixth Form Art Scholarship Programme



Our Art Scholarship students have access to accelerated learning practices in Fine Art, Graphics, Textiles and Photography. They are designed to broaden the knowledge of art for the students involved and enhance their practical and theoretical and technical skills in the subject. This specialist programme will also help them to achieve excellent results in external art examinations. We also prepare students for their chosen Art Foundation and/or undergraduate degree courses.

The Art Department offers four areas of specialism: Fine Art, Textiles, Photography and Graphics. There are 11 specialist teachers in the department. The facilities we offer include a specialist ceramics studio and kiln, a specialist photography studio and Mac suite, a darkroom, and eight general art studios that are used for painting, drawing, sculpture, printmaking, graphics and textiles. The Art Department also has its own gallery to display student work.



Students who gain a scholarship will participate in a wide range of exciting and inspiring opportunities including:

- Workshops and master classes delivered by external tutors from the Dulwich Picture Gallery, the Courtauld Institute, and City & Guilds
- Outreach sessions with practising artists in residence
- Art competitions, including the ARTiculation Prize with the National Gallery
- Discount on the annual Sixth Form Art & Design trip (Berlin, Vienna, Barcelona, St Ives, Prague, Paris, etc.)
- Life drawing at in our art space in Kingswood House

Scholarships constitute an additional £1000 per annum in specialist provision.

Any student wishing to apply for an Art Scholarship will be invited to submit a portfolio of their work. Three-dimensional work should be photographed and presented in the portfolio. We would also encourage the students to include sketchbooks or any supporting work. They may also be invited for an interview.
