Sixth Form Student Dress Code Contract

The uniform policy is based on professional office attire and is a requirement of all students attending Kingsdale Foundation School Sixth Form.

Students have shown a direct correlation between high standards of appearance and high success rates in academic and professional environments.

Please note the following requirements in relation to the Sixth Form dress code:

All students must wear:

- Black, grey or navy smart trousers or skirt
- Plain blouse or collared shirt
- Smart black or brown shoes (no trainers)

Optional:

- Blazer
- Tie

In addition to the requirements above, students are expected to visibly wear their school lanyard with identity card at all times. **This is a compulsory safeguarding requirement.**

Students **are not** allowed to wear the following items of clothing:

- Hats, hoods, or caps
- T-shirts
- Crop tops
- Hooded tops
- Trainers
- Jeans, leggings, or other informal trousers
- Sportswear
- Jean jackets
- Low slung trousers
- Low cut tops
- UGG boots or similar
- Coats inside the main building

Students are **not permitted to use their phones or personal music devices in the main building** in order to set a good example for the younger students.

We will carefully consider any request that is made by students to vary the policy to meet individual needs in line with their religion, beliefs and medical conditions.
