Timetable Duration

Police Pass have devised a revision timetable to assist National Investigators Examination (NIE) candidates to prepare for the examination.

Candidates can choose from either:

- 12 week schedule (recommended);
- 8 week schedule; or
- 6 week schedule.

We recommend following the 12 week timetable to allow yourself adequate time to prepare.

Irrespective of whether you choose to follow the 12 week, 8 week or 6 week schedule – the timetable covers all modules within the syllabus.

4 Phases Of Study

The timetable is split into 4 phases:

- PHASE 1 - GOLD PRIORITY MODULES – 3 OR MORE MARKS IN 1 OR MORE RECENT SITTINGS OF THE NIE
- PHASE 2 - SILVER PRIORITY MODULES – UP TO 2 MARKS IN 1 OR MORE RECENT SITTINGS OF THE NIE
- PHASE 3 BRONZE PRIORITY MODULES – UP TO 1 MARK IN RECENT SITTINGS OF THE NIE
- PHASE 4 – RECAP PHASE – RECAPPING GOLD & SILVER PRIORITY MODULES

Obviously – the longer the revision schedule you select – the more time you will have to work your way through the modules within each respective phase.
