Introduction

- [Zinkers Primary](#) is an educational program for teachers to bring knowledge to primary school classrooms, in which they work on **energy, climate change, environment, and Agenda 2030 concepts**.
- [ZinkersSecondary](#) is an educational program for secondary school teachers and students, in which they work on curricular content on **energy, climate change, air quality, sustainable mobility, and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**.

Talks at schools



Activity

Online talks, with a duration of 55 min. (1 h. lecture), the aim of which is to bring **concepts about the challenges of energy, climate change, and the 2030 Agenda** closer to young people, in a language they can understand.

Repsol at school (Primary Ed.)

Kit designed by Repsol and its Foundation, containing **various materials** that **explain** to primary school children **what Repsol does**, the diversity of the people who work in the company, and **basic concepts about energy**.

It includes **simple activities tailored to each age range**.

Talks (Secondary Ed.)

Talks, prepared by experts from Repsol and its Foundation, **to bring knowledge** to young people in secondary education about the **challenges of the energy transition, sustainable mobility, and the 2030 Agenda**. Volunteers will receive **prior training** in this regard.

It includes **previous activities** for students to research before the talk.

Passes

There will be **4 passes per day** (9:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m., 12:30 p.m. and 3:00 p.m.), depending on the needs and availability of the volunteers.
