RULES

What is the IbizaPreservation Treasure Hunt?

The IbizaPreservation Treasure Hunt is a fun activity aimed at the local community, particularly families. It will take place on Sunday 30th October between 10am and 1pm, starting from the *Palacio de Congresos* in Santa Eulalia. It is organised by IbizaPreservation & Ibiza Blue Challenge and sponsored by the Town Hall of Santa Eulalia, Herbusa, La Sirena, Aguas de Ibiza, Eroski, La Bella Verde & Los Gallegos butchers.

Competitors work in pairs to search for clues in the style of an orienteering race, using a map. Teams can be made up of one adult and a child, or two adults.

The aim is to complete the course and solve hidden clues that relate to the environment and conservation of the island, in the fastest time possible. Participants will have the chance to win an eco-friendly sailing experience for 4 people with La Bella Verde.

How does it work?

The organisers will set you off with your map and instructions from the *Palacio de Congresos* in Santa Eulalia. From there you can run or walk to the different points where the clues are hidden, using the map for reference.

The course will take between 40 minutes and 2 hours to complete. The activity is suitable for all ages as each team can adapt its pace to the appropriate speed. There will be a shorter circuit on offer for those who are participating with younger children.

If at the end of the route you have missed a clue or given an incorrect answer, a time penalty will be added to your final duration: 1 minute per incorrect answer and 6 minutes for skipping a clue.

Who are we?

IbizaPreservation is an environmental foundation that has worked since 2008 to conserve the extraordinary natural value and beauty of Ibiza and Formentera and to promote sustainable initiatives on the islands. To this end, the foundation leads, fosters and participates in projects that aim to protect and regenerate local land and marine habitats.

Ibiza Blue Challenge is an Ibizan company that organises events and sporting activities that promote care and respect for the environment.

Rules and regulations

Article 1: registration

Registration will be open from Friday 23 September at 10am until Friday 28 October at 10am. Registration is free-of-charge and should be done online via sportmaniacs.com.

When registering, indicate the name of the first adult and then the system will ask you to indicate the name of the child or the second adult who makes up the team.

*Your registration includes accident insurance, race bib, map, a complimentary water bottle and a finisher medal for all teams that complete the course.

Article 2: timings

10:00 Distribution of kit to first competitors and start of challenge

13:00 Last entries

14:00 End of competition

*You may arrive and participate whenever you want between 10:00 and 13:00. When you arrive at the organisers' tent, we will give you a number and a map and you can start your race. The meeting point is at the *Palacio de Congresos* in Santa Eulalia (Avda Salvador Camacho 9-11).

Article 3: awards and categories

Categories A and B: The race will consist of two circuits of different levels for those who are participating with younger children. When you come to the event you can decide which circuit you want to do and we will give you the corresponding map.

Category C: for teams made up of two adults.

All teams that complete the course will be awarded a personalised event medal.

IBIZA BLUE CHALLENGE will present the three fastest teams in each of the three categories with a handmade trophy made from recycled materials.

Article 4: eco rules

Participants are reminded that all rubbish must be deposited in the appropriate waste containers. It is strictly forbidden to throw any kind of wrappers or other rubbish on the ground throughout the course.

The organisers will provide refreshments in a special area at the finish line, using recyclable materials and with containers in which to deposit waste. Water refill will be available. Participants are encouraged to bring their own backpacks in order to carry their refreshments, as we do not offer plastic bags and promote reuse.

The organisers will have their solar caravan on site and will use solar energy to power equipment.

Article 5: equipment needed

All participants should wear trainers and comfortable sports clothes. Please avoid bringing single-use plastic water bottles and instead bring your own refillable bottle or use the ones we will provide, plus any other supplies you consider necessary. It is advisable to carry a small backpack per team.

It is compulsory to bring a mobile phone per team and provide this to the organisers as an emergency contact number when registering.

Article 6: responsibility

This event takes place on roads, streets and forest paths and the circuit is open to traffic so you must follow the rules of the road at all times and exercise extreme caution. The adult shall be responsible for the minor they form a team with; they must exercise constant vigilance in order to avoid any incidents.

Article 7: photos

With your registration, you authorise the publication of photos of your child and minors you are responsible for on the Ibiza Blue Challenge and IbizaPreservation social networks and websites, as well as the possible publication of photos by media outlets, which may capture their own images during the course of the race. If you do not wish to authorise this,

please send an email to info@ibizabluechallenge.com indicating the name and surname of the minor whose image you do not wish to be published.
