Reading:

Read or listen to the story of The Magic Porridge Pot-

1. Talk about the story with your family.
 2. Is this a happy or sad story? How do you know? Are the characters kind or evil?
 3. What are the problem's in the story and how are they resolved?
 4. Can you role play creating a magic porridge pot? Who will mix the pot? Who will control the pot and say the magic words?
- Read the word pot-What words rhyme with pot? Can you make a list?

Talking Points

- Which was your favourite piece of art Hugo was looking at?
- What is your favourite piece of art you've done yourself?
- Can you see any examples of art in our home?

Fun Activity

- Make a collage by sticking different things on a piece of paper - ask a grown-up what you can use.
- Don't think too much about it - just stick them on!
- When you're done, ask people in your family what they think it looks like.

Mark Making/Writing:

- Can you remember the words in the story to stop the pot cooking? Write some magical words of your own that you might use to start and stop the pot for e.g. *Izzy Wizzy, let's get busy*. Remember to sound them out carefully. Get a grownup to take a picture of you stirring a large pot with a wooden spoon. The printed photo could be used along with a Speech Bubble to add magic words to the photos.



Lots of fairy tales have Magical elements such as Magic Potions. Magic Potions are used to turn pumpkins into carriages and frogs into Princes! You are going to create your own magic potion, you should include:

- A list of ingredients.
- Directions for how to make it e.g. Next add 2 spoons of glitter.
- Design the bottle, label and packaging e.g. Frog Potion.
- Explain how it is used and what the effect is- Sprinkle on your friend to turn them into a frog.

- In a water tray or sink, explore using some pots and bottles. Can you fill the containers to the top? Can you empty all the water out of the containers? Have fun playing with the bottles and containers. Try using the words 'full, empty and half full to tell a grown up how much water there is inside each container.



- Play a counting game - Count some items into a magic pot and explore adding 1 more or removing an item to show 1 less.
