Nursery Class Teacher

A session in Nursery

Each day you will come into the Nursery cloakroom and hang your coat up. Your peg will have your name and photo on it so you can find it all by yourself. I will be at the door ready to greet you with a smile. Throughout the session you will learn in your key worker groups, have large group time on the carpet and play with your friends indoors and out. We will sing songs and read lots of stories together. You will be given a water bottle to bring to Nursery and we will have milk and fruit while you are here. Some of you who stay all day will go into the dinner hall for lunch before chilling out in our Smarties room where you can sit on the sofa and watch Cbeebies for a little while before going back to Nursery for the afternoon session.

Outdoor area



We have a fantastic outside area that we can use. You can play in the sand pit, use chalks to make pictures, play with water, push the dolls in the prams, build obstacle courses and lots

more lovely things. We have wetsuits and wellies that you will learn to put on so that we can play outside in all weathers and splash in the puddles.

Inside our classrooms



In Nursery we have three key group areas: Circles, Triangles and Squares. You will be shown which of these areas is yours and who your special key grown up will be. We also have a large carpet area where we can sit and learn together, share stories, talk about new topics and sing songs in a circle. Sometimes we work with an adult and sometimes we work by ourselves. We have a creative area, writing area, reading area, maths area, role play area, playdough area, sand area, water area, construction and small world areas for you to learn in. Throughout your weeks in Nursery, we will learn about different topics such as Autumn, Harvest, Christmas, Easter, Chinese New Year, People who Help us and many more. Our first topic will be “Wonderful me!” and we will learn all about you and your families.
