My name is Mrs Willis and I have been Head Teacher here at Biddick Hall Infant and Nursery School since September 2016. At this point in the school year I am always looking forward to welcoming a new group of children into our nursery.

Coronavirus has changed things for our school in terms of how we manage the transition from home to nursery for our children. We would usually arrange visits to meet your children in their own homes and invite parents into school. However, we are now having to plan alternative ways of helping our new starters get ready for nursery.

Parents are now likely to miss out on physically coming into school with their child on their first day and I realise many of you have many questions or even concerns so I aim to share with you as much information as I can about transition. How you can prepare your child at home

You can help your child with routines such as getting a good night's sleep and key skills like getting dressed and undressed and using the toilet and washing their hands independently.

Please use the time you have together to talk with your child and engage in activities like baking, getting out into the garden or local area and sharing books and rhymes and reading stories.

Please talk to your child about the transition in age appropriate ways, they do not need to know the details of why things are different. Please share with them that you have received this message from school about when they will start nursery. This remains a really important and exciting time for you and your child and we are excited too.
