<u>Impact of Premium Use</u>	
Impact on pupils' participation	<p>The installation of new trim trail has really engaged the children. It has encouraged more to take part in physical activity and ensured that they are becoming more active.</p> <p>They are becoming much more confident in their own abilities in regards to physical activity and they are showing a high level of enjoyment as a result.</p>
Impact on pupils' attainment	<p>The purchase of a new PE scheme has got children showing a high level of enthusiasm when taking part in the new games and activities. They have more opportunities to develop and explore their skills during lessons and they are confident in talking about their learning and physical skills.</p> <p>Children have an increased skill level in PE from better training and leadership resulting in an increased chance of success in competitive sport.</p>
How the premium has allowed pupils to develop active lifestyles	<p>The new games and activities that the children have participated in have encouraged them to participate more in active games at playtimes and children are exploring new games to play.</p> <p>The children have shown an increased interest in being active through the use of the outdoor equipment. Children have been shown how to correctly use the playground equipment to ensure they are being more active during break time.</p>
How the school will sustain the improvements	<p>New plans and schemes will be monitored closely and their implementation will be overseen by the PE co-ordinator. As the new scheme is implemented further, reviews of the sports equipment will take place to ensure the correct equipment is available at all times.</p> <p>The use of the new outdoor equipment in the outdoor area will be used every day as part of the outdoor provision and will be timetabled in to help develop gross motor skills. This will have a huge impact on the children's abilities as they progress through school.</p>
