(Specialist Role - Health & Safety)**

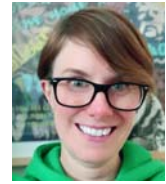
I have 2 children, one at Enfield Grammar. I work as a Quality Leader within an international engineering company. I previously worked in various manufacturing industries as an engineer and manager.
