

School Uniform

We believe that wearing our school uniform creates a sense of pride and belonging for our children. We encourage all children to attend school looking smart and ready to learn.

The school uniform is a grey sweatshirt/cardigan with dark grey trousers/skirt and white polo shirt. In the summer pupils can wear blue gingham dresses/grey shorts. Sweatshirts and cardigans which feature the school logo are available to order or those in plain grey which can be purchased from a wide range of outlets are perfectly acceptable.



Pupils should wear sensible black shoes (no heels) or **plain black** trainers.

PE kit

Plain white t-shirt with navy blue shorts.

Plain navy, black or grey jogging bottoms can be worn for outdoor PE. Sweatshirts in the same colours or a school sweatshirt can also be worn outdoors.

Trainers (any colour) or plimsolls.

PE kits should be kept in a sensibly sized named bag. The bag should be kept in school all week and taken home at the weekends for the kit to be washed.

We ask that all children attend school appropriately dressed and prepared for their day at school. Suitable outdoor clothing should be worn to ensure that children remain comfortable when playing outside or taking part in outdoor learning activities.



Other items

Our school reading bags are reasonably priced, robust and can be used for years. We hope that children will use these to transport books, homework and letters between home and school. These can be ordered along with uniform.



During the warmer months we encourage children to wear a cap to protect them from the sun during breaks and lunchtimes.
