# **Information for Parents/Carers 4th January 2021**

Following the announcement from the Prime Minister yesterday we would like to update you as much as possible on our plans for the weeks and months ahead. We keep all our pupils and their families in our prayers and are aware that the recent announcements put some families under increased pressure. We are working hard to provide the best possible educational experience for your children at this time.

### **Arbor Parental Portal**

As I have previously mentioned, we are now using a new MIS system called Arbor which is able to communicate to you a range of information and deal with things such as consent for school trips, photographs etc. As communication is so important in these ever-changing times we feel that launching this app is now of paramount importance. It is particularly relevant for gaining your consent for the testing programme we have been instructed to carry out by the government. You will shortly receive an email detailing how to access the Arbor parental portal. Please follow the instructions provided as this will gradually become the main communication methodology the school will use to relay information to you. Whilst it does not currently make 'parent pay' redundant, it will eventually replace it as the main method of communication.

# Y11 Examinations

We do not have definitive guidance on the government's intentions for assessing pupils in Y11 this academic year. We would urge you to stress to your children the importance of attending live lessons during this period of school closure as assessments may be conducted when we return to school which may significantly influence any judgement on pupil attainment and progress that the government may ask us to make. We are here to support your child's learning and staff will provide high quality online learning which your children must access and respond to. As soon as we have clear guidance on how assessment will be conducted we will let you know.



## Timetable changes

During the week before Christmas, we issued new timetables to pupils in all year groups which they glued into their planners. The changes to the timetable involved some lessons moving to a different day/time but the class and the teacher staying the same. **Your child should follow this new timetable - in most cases, each of these lessons will be a live lesson that they will be expected to attend remotely until schools re-open.** We will email a copy of the timetable today. ### **Live Lessons**

Teachers will be teaching live lessons from Tuesday 5th January Period 1. This means that your child will receive a Google Meet invite through their Google Classroom and will be able to remote into the lesson as the teacher delivers it live in school. Please remind your child to mute their microphone and switch off their camera during the live lessons, they need to use the chat function to ask a question.
