



Hyde Community College Covid-19 Pupil Protocols

Pupils who are displaying symptoms of Covid-19 must NOT attend school.

All pupils must:

Arrive at school **at their allotted time.**

Walk or cycle to school where possible. If public transport is used, pupils must follow all social distancing guidance.

Not loiter outside the school gates at the start or end of the day.

Come in through the front gates and go around the right hand side of the building to enter through the Food Tech rooms.

Use the distancing markers whilst entering school (stay 2 metres apart).

Wash/Sanitise their hands on arrival.

Observe social distancing at all times during the day, inside the building and outside.

Follow all hygiene guidance at all times (see posters re hand-washing and 'catch it, kill it, bin it').

Follow any one-way systems in operation.

Stay within their designated hub area at all times, this includes toilets, printing, ICT provision, break and lunchtime.

Remain in their allocated seats unless directed otherwise by a member of staff.

Use the allocated toilets only, observe social distancing and hygiene routines.

Bring basic equipment (i.e. pen, pencil, ruler).

Do NOT bring anything else with you apart from your packed lunch and drink.

Wash/sanitise their hands throughout the day and in particular between sessions and before and after eating.

Ensure that any personal hand sanitiser is allowed to dry fully before touching any surfaces.

Use the lift one at a time if they have a lift pass.

Bring their own packed lunches and drink/full water bottle (school water fountains are out of use).

Remember - no chewing gum.

Behave in line with the school's usual high expectations.

Leave their work space clear at the end of each session.

Leave the school building and make their way straight home at the end of their session.

Please note: pupils do not have to wear school uniform but all clothing must be appropriate for school e.g. no strappy tops, bare bellies, short shorts/skirts, slogans with the potential to cause offence etc.

Pupils are welcome to wear face masks if they wish to, but must provide their own.

Any pupil deliberately failing to comply with these protocols will be sent home.
