Who we are

St Martin-in-the-Fields is a unique configuration of cultural, charitable and commercial initiatives rooted in the life of a vibrant Church of England congregation. Our vision is *At the heart. It also names our calling to be on the edge, not just of Trafalgar Square but alongside those on the edge through being excluded, ignored or oppressed by society or church, and on the cutting edge of innovation in culture, commerce, charity and congregational life.

About the department

The café has 224 seats, open 7 days a week, and provides in house catering for events, conferences and private dining. In addition we offer a seasonal outdoor dining, The Courtyard at St Martin's which opens from April to October. The daily changing buffet offers freshly prepared value for money food and attracts a mix of people from local office workers and residents to tourists from all over the world. It has been a successful component of the commercial operations at St Martin's for over 30 years, and has recently been awarded the Trip Advisor Certificate of Excellence.

Visitors to Café in the Crypt, and The Courtyard at St Martin's are delighted by the range, choice and options available when they arrive to experience one or both of the Café's or when attending an Event, private function or conference. An amazing venue in the heart of London which offers great value, freshly cooked food, a unique venue for entertaining and a TripAdvisor Certificate of Excellence.

The Café is open every day (except for Christmas and Boxing Day), generally from 10.00 to 21.00 serving a range of breakfasts, lunches, dinners and afternoon tea. On top of this, the Café is host to a weekly Jazz night and many daytime and evening events, functions and conferences.

Job Profile

1 Operations

- Always trying to minimise breakages and losses
- Adhere to opening and closing procedures
- Correct and proper set up of stocked areas at all times
- To follow all kitchen cleaning rotas on a am/pm daily routine as displayed in all areas of the kitchens
- Washing and drying of cutlery, crockery and table trays, which if need be, washed and dried manually
- To ensure that items which are sent to be recycled, are disposed of in the correct areas and in correct bags and containers provided
- The removal of daily rubbish at times stated on a am/pm programme and placed in the correct areas and waste bins provided
- Storage of dry goods to be correctly stored and using a stock rota system on the advice of the Head Chef
- Removal of packaging from dry goods area and cleaning of after each delivery

2 Customer service

- Provide and maintain good customer service
- Build a strong working relationship with the front of house team, kitchen team and across site team
- Maintain an organised and clean environment in all kitchen areas

3 Health and safety

- Practice good health and safety procedures at all times, report any operational problems which may interfere with work to Head Chef, Executive Chef, Duty Manager or appropriate team
- Maintain a high level of cleanliness in your immediate working area and strictly adhere to cleaning rota schedule
- Be able to use and clean all machinery in use in accordance with manufacturers guidelines and safely

4 Performance and personal development

- Build a strong working relationship with catering team and cross site team
- Undertake all relevant training for the role
