Hold Brake Pedal to reverse in Automatic Gear Mode.

Wipers have 3 settings, Off, High and Low.

Clutchpedal can be used as "reset to track".

Note that you cannot reset to track if any

cars are passing, or stand next to you.

H-Gear shifter has two settings, Sequential or H-Gear. Use lever at base of shifter to switch between modes.

There are also sequential shifters behind the steering wheel. Right for Up-Shift, and left for Down-Shift. Most cars don't have a working handbrake, so only use when instructed. Use it gently, very little force required.

Brake Pedal is hydraulic and requires some pressure to be effective. Down to the right on the Speedometer, you can monitor the pedal travel, to see if you press hard enough.

Virtual Dash up/down is useful if the dials are obstructed by the steering wheel.

ESP requires TSC and ABS to work. When you engage ESP, TCS and ABS will automatically be activated

When you are being seated in the simulator, please refrain from adjusting seat, pedals or steering wheel. Our operators will make all the neccessary adjustments. Operators will also give you your headset when ready.
