The rule book states that junior players playing up into senior leagues must be aged 14 on the 1<sup>st</sup> January the year the season starts. This means that players aged 14 years 10 months can play senior from the 1<sup>st</sup> of October, provided that the appropriate parental and team manager approvals are accepted and approved by the regional committee.

It has been suggested and approved by the UKIHF Committee that leagues which start on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current season, in this case specifically for South West region, that once a player turns 15, they are allowed to play up into their B league, which is effectively their development league.

This applies at this point to the South West B league only.
